<u>Criteria #1: The work is visually engaging, dynamic, and highlights the creative potential of video as a medium.</u>

4-5 out of 5 ranking: The Artwork Description and Sample are in significant or total alignment with the statement above.

3 out of 5 ranking: The Artwork Description and Sample share some alignment with the statement above.

1-2 out of 5 ranking: The Artwork Description and Sample have little to no alignment with the statement above.

Criteria #2: The artist/s and their work exemplify the values of Millwork Commons.

4-5 out of 5 ranking: The Artist Statement meaningfully reflects and/or incorporates the values of Millwork Commons.

3 out of 5 ranking: The Artist Statement somewhat reflects and/or incorporates the values of Millwork Commons

1-2 out of 5 ranking: The Artist Statement includes little to no reflection and/or incorporation of the values of Millwork Commons.

Criteria #3: The artwork meets the following criteria:

- works well without sound;
- is visually accessible, meaning it presents content in a manner that can be easily seen and/or understood by people with visual impairments;
- does not include elements that may trigger photosensitivity such as high-frequency flashing, high-contrast patterns, and intense light sources;
- does not depict the following content:
 - Political propaganda
 - Religious propaganda
 - Explicit: Includes foul language, violence, sexually explicit, or trauma-inducing depictions.

4-5 out of 5 ranking: The Submission Sample (and full work) meets all of the above criteria.

3 out of 5 ranking: The Submission Sample (and full work) meets most of the above criteria, but produces some questions or uncertainty.

1-2 out of 5 ranking: The Submission Sample (and full work) meets little to none of the above criteria and produces significant questions and/or concerns.
